International Fee Schedule

Registration Fee

New registrants are required to pay a one time, **non-refundable**, administrative fee of \$250./child, which must be submitted with the Application for Admission form.

Deposit

A deposit of \$750./child, is required prior to receiving a Letter of Acceptance. MVA will provide a full refund of the \$750 only if the Study Permit application is declined by the government. A copy of the government rejection letter must be submitted to MVA in order to receive the refund. The \$750 deposit will be deducted from the tuition.

Tuition

MVA offers a 10% tuition reduction to each registered, full-time sibling(s). The discounts apply to tuition fees only and do not apply to other fees.

Tuition Guarantee

It should be noted that **the obligation is to pay a full year's tuition fee and no reduction or remission will be allowed** in the case of temporary absence, withdrawal or dismissal. We are obligated to provide the parents and students of Mountain View Academy with the highest quality of education. The staffs is hired according to our registered student numbers at the beginning of the school year. The small nature of the school means the mid-year withdrawal of a student's funds could have a substantial impact on the quality of the education for those students remaining, if this guarantee was not honoured.

The registration fee and deposit are non-refundable.

ECS (Enriched Kindergarten program Monday – Friday full day)

Full Year \$11,5 00.

Payment may be made in lump sum or in two equal payments. The first payment is due upon registration. Please note that there is an administrative fee of 2% (\$220.) for the payment plan. The second payment is due February 1. These fees are non-refundable. The financial supporter is responsible for the entire year's cost.

Grades One through Six

Full Year \$11,500.

Grades Seven through Nine

Full Year \$11,500.

Payment may be made in lump sum in two equal payments. The first payment is due upon registration. Please note that there is an administrative fee of 2% (\$220.) for the payment plan. The second payment is due February 1. These fees are non-refundable. The financial supporter is responsible for the entire year's cost.

Grades Ten through Twelve

Full Year \$11,500.

Payment may be made in lump sum or in two equal payments. The first payment is due upon registration (please note that there is an administrative fee of 2% for the payment plan). The second payment is due February 1. These fees are non-refundable. The financial supporter is responsible for the entire year's cost. **Diploma Exams**

are not included in the tuition. The Diploma Exam fees are set by Alberta Learning at \$50 fee per exam (including re-writes) which is the responsibility of the financial supporter.

Note: Please note that prices do not include uniforms, gym strip, transportation (if applicable) or mandatory offsite physical education programs. **All fees are non-refundable.**

MVA Membership Fee

Upon registration there will be a one time, **non-refundable**, \$2,500. Mountain View Academy Society membership fee per family for students registered in kindergarten through grade 12.

Volunteer Deposit

ALL GRADES – ONE CHILD	\$500.
ALL GRADES – FAMILY (more than one child)	\$800.

The volunteer deposit covers the cost of the growth to our programs, services and facilities. This fee constitutes each family's commitment to Mountain View Academy through volunteerism. A total of **40 hours per child** is required to receive a full refund. A tax deductible income tax receipt is available to those families who wish to donate their portion directly or families can work towards having all or a portion of their fees returned. It is the responsibility of each individual family to keep a record of their cumulative volunteer hours throughout the year. Volunteer hours must be submitted to the office no later than August 31 (of the same school year) for a refund. The year will be calculated from September to August. Sorry, additional hours volunteered do not accrue as a credit.

Student Visa Letters/Documentation

Upon acceptance of international students, Mountain View Academy will provide one letter for visa purposes indicating that the student has been accepted at MVA. There will be a nominal fee of \$20 per letter/documentation (ie. letters, certificate of awards, extra report cards, etc.) thereafter. The school must receive one week notice for any letters/documentation required. **Students will not be permitted to attend class if they cannot produce their student visa prior to start date.**

School Uniforms

School Uniforms are an additional cost. Uniforms are supplied by Elegant Design. Please refer to the MVA website for further information www.mountainviewacademy.ca.

Physical Education uniforms are provided by Metromedia and are ordered through the MVA website www.mountainviewacademy.ca under Parents, School Gym Strip and Supply. Please note that the school uniform and the gym strip are two different suppliers.
